Consumer complaint numbers 189298, 189299, and 189300 were filed with the FDA and derives from the same owner spanning dogs. This complaint states a dog became ill after consuming Answer Pet Food brand raw, ready-to-eat Straight Chicken Formula pet food. These complaints were received during the inspection. The FDA sampled two (2) lots from a distributor in (b)(4). The results were reported as follows:

Sample 1270740 is Straight Chicken Lot Jan 02, 2026, was positive for Salmonella Kentucky.

Sample 1270741 is Straight Chicken Lot Mar 11, 2026, was positive for Salmonella Typhimurium.

On 10/03/2024, Investigators Covill and Nardelli reviewed the batch records for these lots.

Discrepancies with the firm's production and sanitation procedures are documented on a Form FDA 483.

According to Mr. Shawver and Mr. Strawser, they were not aware of the consumer complaints until the compliance calls with FDA on 08/27/2024. They have requested left over samples from these lots from the FDA. They sent samples to (b)(4) for analysis. The results are pending.
